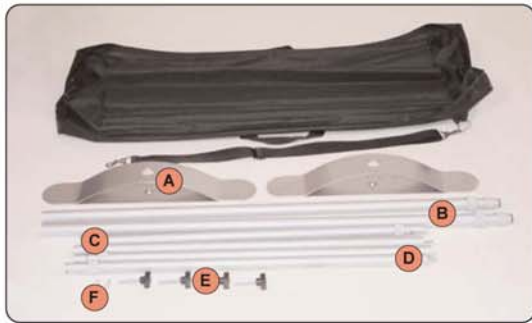

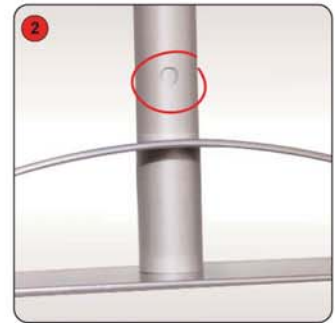
Assembly Instructions



Kit includes: 2 x feet (A), 2 x telescopic upright poles (B), 2 x top rail poles (C) and 2 x bottom rail poles (D), 4 x pole screws (E) and 2 x foot screws (F)



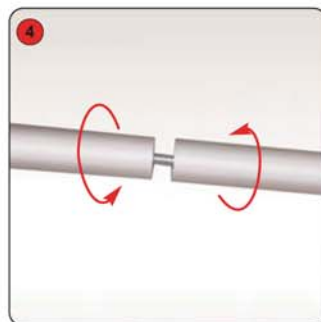
1 Insert a telescopic upright pole (B) through one foot (A) and tighten supplied screw (F) with screwdriver to secure fit



2 Make sure that the mounting hole is facing the long side of each foot. Repeat step 1 and 2 with the other foot and pole.



3 Locate the two top poles (C) and two bottom poles (D) which are labelled accordingly



4 Twist the two top poles together (with the writing appearing at either end). Repeat for the bottom poles



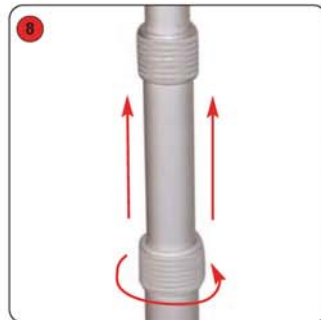
5 Slide the top pole through the looped graphic and adjust length of pole so that at least 50mm is sticking out either end



6 Take one of the pole screws (E) and screw through the upright and into the top rail. Repeat for other end.



7 Slide bottom pole through the bottom of the looped graphic and attach to both uprights with pole screws.



8 To adjust the height of the upright poles so that the graphic fits, twist and pull out each pole as indicated. Twist in the opposite direction to secure.
